

OUR LAKE

Our lake was named "Lake Heron" and covers approximately 60 acres. The lake was formed during the construction of Interstate 95 and two sand pits remained after construction was completed. The two lakes were then renamed Forest Lakes.

A portion of land separating the two lakes was removed leaving a peninsula. The fill was used to build up that common ground. Forest Lakes is a "catch basin" for drainage of the surrounding area. A weir is located in the southeast corner of the lake.

Gasoline powered boats are not allowed on the lake, only small battery operated trolling motors. Boat access is by a ramp located at the southwest end of the lake.

You will find large-mouth bass, brim, catfish, turtles, and an occasional alligator. A fishing license is not required because it is a privately owned lake.
