Message from the Board

Please become familiar with "The Rules We Live By" - - copies are available at the Association Office. Below are just a few reminders:

- (1) All guests, renters, must be properly registered in the Association Office. Office hours are 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon, Monday – Friday.
- (2) RV and Mobile Home Appearance – Residents are to maintain the exterior of the unit in a clean, attractive and well-kept fashion.
- (3) Pets are to be kept within the resident's RV or mobile home except when the resident has the pet on a leash and is walking the pet
- (4) Owners or persons walking a pet are to pick up any excretion and dispose of it in a sanitary manner.
- (5) Clutter – unsightly items are not permitted to remain outside the RV or mobile home. This includes overstuffed furniture, refrigerators, washers, dryers etc.
- (6) Speed Limit – 10 mph on one-way streets (Forest Lakes and Blue Lake Drive); 15mph on two-way streets (Rosewood and Fig).
- (7) For safety reasons – drivers are encouraged to watch for walkers and bicyclists on all streets.
- (8) On-site short-term parking of RV (one or two days) is permitted for loading and unloading. No overnight parking on lawns is permitted.
- (9) Additions and Alterations – must be approved by the Architectural Committee. Questions should be directed to Pat Johnson, Director of Architecture.
- (10) Visitors using park facilities, shuffleboard, pool, etc., must wear a bracelet signifying that they are a visitor. Bracelets are available in the Association Office.

The Board encourages all unit owners to become familiar with the "rules". Next Board Meeting is February 10th at 7 PM.

Plastics Cause Failure of Lift Station Pumps

The lift station is the most needed and valuable assets to our community. A recent problem with one of our lift station pumps revealed that someone had flushed some sort of plastic product into our privately owned sewer system, destroying one of our valuable pumps. This error will cost the Association between 9 to 10 thousand dollars to purchase a new pump

While it is difficult to determine how and why someone would flush plastics into the sewer system, we know that plastics caused the problem. Our system is not designed to handle disposal of plastics, i.e., diapers/pampers, depends, bed pads, plastic grocery bags, etc.

We must use good judgement by not flushing any of the items listed above as well as any other plastic items you might be tempted to throw in – nothing more than fecal waste and toilet paper should go down the sewer.

Please, please do your part by never, ever, flush plastics of any kind into the sewer system.

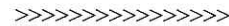
Spaghetti Dinner Feb 8th
